Example, a Bidder can't provide the Globe and/or Morning Pride product specified in the bid. The Company shall email the City and clearly state that they plan to submit a proposed Alternate for the Globe and/or Morning Pride gear, proposed manufacturer name ABC, proposed style number ABC123, and a general description by 12 pm EST on June 1.

Please note that the specifications may include enhancements to the currently worn firefighting turnout gear by both the City of Charlotte and City of Asheville. Per Section 1.22, all Bidders are allowed to submit proposed Alternates to the currently worn turnout gear. City of Asheville currently wears Morning Pride #LTO-41i3TB (Coat) and #LTO-41i3PB (Pant).

- June 29: Bidders must notify Procurement Management in writing if they desire to inspect samples
- July 11: Samples, Client References, Specification Compliance Sheets, and Sample Reporting

- Aug.18: City will issue Phase Two of ITB
- Aug. 30: Bids are due
